**DISCUSSION DETAILS:**

**• Field House Update**

Sandy Allen discussed that she and Tom Edwards will be meeting with Dr. Cheryl Thomas (Supt.) tomorrow morning to discuss the progress of the Field House. Tom will be speaking with Tom Addy about electrical progress before this meeting too. Tom A. will also be speaking about this matter at the 6/17 Board Meeting; Jay Dunham may be able to attend this with him.

Sandy has spoken to Ray Rawn about the Field House being left unlocked and he'll be changing the locks to be Booster locks ONLY. Jay added that Ray's Asst., Kevin, has had to note when they've accessed the Field House and as to whether or not the doors were unlocked.

Tom said that the plumbing fixtures have been purchased by the school so, we'll need to follow up on that with the plumber. He did recently talk with Matt Carney about possibly putting in metal ceilings. Matt suggested that they're easier to install and easier to keep clean. Betsy Edwards asked if this would be more expensive and Tina Henry asked whether they'd be mildew resistant. Tom answered with yes possibly more expensive and definitely more mildew resistant. Jay asked about the lights that Ray has in storage. Betsy replied that Ray has them and if he's missing anything for them he'll order parts and it won't be a problem. She'll have Ray talk to Tom about it. Sandy added that the painter is just waiting on us to contact them and Betsy has spoken to the Art Dept. for a student reference to paint a Trojan Head (Cal Henry was referred).

Jay said that TetraTech has issued an order for joist hangers (hurricane hold down) and that the contractor is refusing to install them; they're asking the Booster Club to do it. Sandy replied that we'll have to ask Cheryl Thomas about this.

Betsy asked what our responsibilities are. Tom and Jay replied with; hanging ceilings dry-walling, painting and bathroom installations. The School covered bringing the electricity to the Field House and we've been responsible for everything after that. Tom and Betsy suggested that we eventually get a phone tree for a 10-12 person crew of volunteers. Tina added that Football parents could be asked to help at the 8/13 equipment hand out and Tom mentioned that we'll need to coordinate this with Dan Donahue. Sandy had heard that the numbers of Foot Ball players signed up is high and Ricky Stewart thought the numbers could possibly be including Modified.

Betsy mentioned that Cornell Premier Catering has donated 2 pretzel and 2 cookie warming machines that we could use in the Field House. She also wondered if we wanted the 2 apartment sized stoves for the concession area. Both Sandy and Tina replied with yes; to be used for baking pretzels/cookies. Tom suggested that maybe we'd want a chest freezer from Lowe's and Sandy prefers an upright but, felt a chest freezer would work too. Betsy asked about the cupboards for the concession area and Sandy replied with we'll want some to be lockable; maybe the Home Ec. Wooden ones can be made lockable. Jay suggested that we do an inventory of what we have and then decide on the concession layout. Betsy added that Rynone's will do a design for us once we get them the Pepsi cooler measurements. Sandy will follow up with Pepsi and she's fine with us using the recycled cabinets.
