**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer's report was discussed and all in attendance approved.

**MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** September minutes were approved by all in attendance.

#### **DISCUSSION DETAILS:**

##### **• Field House Update**

Sandy Allen recently emailed Vicky Volpicelli (Interim Superintendent) regarding our concerns and disappointment in the progress of the Field House roof, etc. Vicky did reply to say that the metal roof arrived on 10/16 and will be installed in 2 weeks. Sandy added that we can't do anything until the roof is finished. She also discussed the large gap that's in front of the Concession windows and the fact that Bill Hurley thought we'd need to repair it but, contractors have placed metal pieces to cover it.

Betsy Edwards pointed out that we'd been misled about the electricity being our entire responsibility. She added that it shouldn't be our burden. Sandy pointed out that we should go to the Board of Education and request more money, and Betsy agreed.

Tina Henry added that we will want to be resourceful and not spend all of Booster monies on this project; as we have other sports to consider.

Mitch Gray noted that electric/plumbing "roughing in" just means that the service is there but, the Booster Club is responsible to connect to the service. Mitch, Sandy and Betsy asked about whether or not the Boiler will also be our responsibility. Sandy mentioned that the completion of the public restrooms will also be brought up to the Board. **Sandy will request that the Booster Club get on the agenda for an upcoming Board meeting in November and Mitch agreed to be there as a Booster Representative with questions/concerns.**

Betsy indicated that 2 people from Rynone Manufacturing will be here tomorrow (10/20) at 3:30 PM to give plan ideas on the Concession area if anyone is interested. Sandy asked Lucy Ferrara about the drink coolers for the Concession area and she indicated that if Pepsi gives us any trouble about replacement then we'll switch to Coke.

##### **• Concession Sign-Ups**

Volleyball on 10/20 and 10/26; Modified Football on 10/22 are all covered. Betsy will get out a request letter for concession volunteers after Sandy and Lucy proof read it.

##### **• Fundraising Requests**

Betsy asked about 50/50s at Basketball games as fundraising for both the All Night Party and Class of 2010. Sandy indicated that there are other classes that have made requests for this too and it was agreed that each class (2010, 2012, 2013) share the 50/50s (1 Boys and 1 Girls game for each). Betsy asked about a half-time ball toss fundraiser at HOME Basketball games, for the All Night Party, in which prizes would hopefully be donated.

**Jeff Augustine indicated that all HOME Basketball games are at 5:30 PM and that some of the AWAY will be at 6 PM.**

**• Misc. Discussion**

Students Traveling Abroad for Sports -

Sandy discussed the possibility of revising our policy on contributing money to a student traveling abroad for a sport. Jeff added that his concern is that there's false advertising by companies that claim to be recruiting for Section IV All-Stars and that these misleading programs don't meet the appropriate criteria. Jeff believes that our policy is appropriate to make a student process a request through the Booster Club. Sandy added that we'll keep our policy in place.

Norm Wall Scholarship –

The Norm Wall Golf Tournament was very successful and all in attendance agreed to donate \$600 to the Norm Wall Scholarship. **Capri Moseley and Brad Werner were the recipients for 2009 and we need to get Brad his award now that we have the paperwork.** Sandy questioned whether or not we'd like to lower the future awarded amounts. Mitch indicated that since the Scholarship generates from the Golf Tournament we should keep it at \$500 unless the Tournament were ever to dissolve. All in attendance agreed to keep the award money amount at \$500.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 PM. All in attendance were in favor.
