### DISCUSSION DETAILS:

#### NEW BUSINESS:

- **Projection system for basketball games – larger screen? Camera?**

The current system, Booster Club paid for, however, the screen isn't big enough for the concession workers to see. Even up close, you can't really read the scoreboard. Will talk to Paul and see if they can move the screen to in front of the trophy case. Linda did some checking on bigger screens they run upwards to \$600.00. Jeff Augustine would like to see Booster Club purchase other items besides a bigger screen. Some of his suggestions were as follows:

- Request digital video camera for use for all sporting seasons

- Jeff is trying to get the weight room expanded and would like to see BC purchase possible mirrors, accomplishment boards, ect.

- Some one brought up nice chairs for the teams – the ones with thick pad and logo on back. There is an issue about storage.

- The scoreboard was also brought up again.

- Team uniforms- Per Jeff, these will be purchased by the school on a 4 year cycle. This means that the modified sports will not get new items yet. There is a large number of girls on the modified basketball team, Betsy made the motion to purchase inexpensive shirts, similar to the rec. bball program shirts, Lucy 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all were in favor. We will see how many shirts will be needed, Sandy will help with getting these.
