DISCUSSION DETAILS:

Old Business:

- Proposed Change Article #2 – Type of Assistance:
 - C. To assist individual students in special invitational events.
 - 1. Method- The student athlete shall submit a request to the Athletic Director and Booster Club with proof of acceptance or letter of invitation. Student must be playing a varsity sport in the coming season (at Newfield) and the request must be related to that varsity sport. The student must have the recommendation of the varsity coach for their sport. The event or team must be determined either an honor for the individual student's success and/or contribute to the success of the student's school team.
 - 2. Funding- The Booster Club will make out a check to the event for the individual for up to half of the amount of the fee not to exceed \$250.00. There will be a maximum of \$750.00 for all team members of a single team per season. With amounts for 1 year at a time, adjustable from year to year by vote of membership.
- The above change to the bylaws was voted on and approved by all.
- Update on the baseball fields:

- Roy Westmiller has taken down the old dugout and expects to start the drainage the the fields this week (10/04/2004).
- Update of Gold card sales:
 - There were a total of 308 cards sold. Each team that sold cards will get \$3.00 per card sold. The top 3 sales people will earn the following: 1 – 2 free cards and \$1.00 per card sold; 2 – 2 free cards and \$0.75 per card sold and 3 – 2 free cards and \$0.50 per card sold.
