### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### **Donation to the Spencer VanEtten Booster Club**

Sandy brought up the suggestion of giving the Spencer VanEtten Booster Club a portion of the profits from our Homecoming game against SVE. Bruce Hunter made the motion to donate \$500.00 to them for their sports programs through the Booster Club. All were in favor of donating the \$500.00. We are going to advertise that some of the profits from the Newfield vs. SVE Homecoming game are going to be donated to the SVE Booster Club. Sandy is going to talk to Sue France and have it put in the handout given at the ticket stand. We volunteered Linda Poppleton to write something up for the Newfield News. We are also going to make a sign to put on the Booster Buggy.

#### **Request from Sharon Powell for new band uniforms**

Sharon Powell presented the Booster Club with information from a school that is currently interested in selling their marching band uniforms. The colors are great for Newfield. The asking price is \$50.00 per uniform, the cost new is approx. \$200-300.00. Sharon has approx. 75 kids in band at this time. She would like to purchase at least 100 uniforms. The uniforms consist of pants and jacket/shirt. Newfield already owns hats (that match nicely). WE STATED THAT WE WOULD GET BACK TO HER. AFTER SHE LEFT, WE CAME BACK TO THIS DISCUSSION AND THIS IS WHAT WAS DECIDED: Our Bylaws state that we are for the athletic programs, and if we gave them money or let them have profits from the Booster Buggy, then we would open ourselves up to more non-athletic groups approaching us. We decided that due to the fact that the Pep Band does play for all of our home football games, we would let an adult Pep Band member sell 50/50 tickets at the last 3 remaining home games and Booster Club will keep the money earmarked for them for the uniform purchase at which time they will receive the money.

#### **Gold Cards**

The Gold Cards have been handed out for the athletes to sell. They are \$10.00 each, with \$5.00 going to the card company and the remainder to be split as follows: \$2.00 to the Booster Club and the team will receive \$3.00 per card sold. If 500 cards are sold then the highest selling team will receive a pizza party and \$100.00. Individuals will receive 1 gold card per every 10 cards sold. In addition to receiving the gold card, the Top 3 sellers will also receive: 1 top seller- \$1.00 per card sold; 2 top seller - \$0.75 per card sold; 3 top seller - \$0.50 per card sold.

#### **Ideas for items for fall sports**

Some items will be hats, beanies and briefcase with Newfield Trojans on them – these will sell for a reasonable price. The briefcase is very similar to the current one, but costs less money. Sue made the motion to purchase the hats and beanies, Barb seconded the motion, all were in favor. Tina made the motion to purchase the briefcase and Lucy seconded the motion, all were in favor. These items will be ordered.
